1. Entry Deadline - **WEDNESDAY, MAY 20, 2026 5 P.M.**
2. The deadline for all livestock entries is 5:00 p.m. **WEDNESDAY, MAY 20, 2026**, to the Secretary's Office.
3. Premise ID # must be provided when entries are made.
4. There will be no refunds or changes on entries after **WEDNESDAY, MAY 20th.**
5. Entry fees must be paid at the time of entry on all livestock.
6. All entries are subject to General and Livestock Rules and Regulations.
7. The number and location of stalls per exhibitor will be assigned by the Superintendent. Animals must be stalled by 8:00 a.m. **WEDNESDAY, MAY 27th.**
8. Health papers will be checked between **9-10 A.M. WEDNESDAY, MAY 27th**, in the Cattle Barn Show Ring.
9. Owners must furnish all pails for watering animals.
10. Each animal must be under halter in charge of its owner or helper when on exhibition in show ring.
11. No hay may be stored in a stall and aisles must be kept open.
12. No straw allowed in barn or in tie-outs. Bedding may be purchased from the fair association @ \$5.00 per head.
13. Classes will start at **8:00 A.M. THURSDAY, MAY 28th.**
14. Valid proof of social security number will be required day of show.
 - Steers will be weighed at 9:00 A.M. the day before showing. (STEER SHOW WILL IMMEDIATELY FOLLOW THE OPEN SHOW.) If more than seven (7) steers are entered in a breed, that STEER CLASS will be split into LIGHT & HEAVY CLASSES. If more than fourteen (14) steers are entered, the STEER CLASS will be divided into LIGHT, MEDIUM & HEAVY CLASSES. Beef Cattle will be released immediately after the Steer Show. Show Order is as listed. All other purebred steers will show in crossbred steer classes.
